What Will We Do?

Friday Night

Saturday

Rules

- 1. Scouts and siblings are NOT ALLOWED at camp without a parent or guardian, even temporarily. If you must leave, you must take your children with you.
- Each person at camp will have a current medical form on file; adults and siblings included. You will not be able to set up camp until the forms are complete and on file.
- No dogs or other pets allowed at camp with the exception of certified service animals.
 Such animals must be kept on lead at all times.
- 4. No alcohol or illegal drugs, fireworks or firearms allowed at camp.
- No youth is allowed to sleep in the tent of an adult other than their own parent or guardian.
- 6. Only Scouts possessing the Whittling Chip may carry a pocket knife.
- No electronics of any kind may be used by Scouts or siblings participating in the camp program. This includes phones / tablets etc.
- 8. Class A uniforms must be worn when traveling to and from camp and during flag and religious ceremonies. Class B shirts may be worn the rest of time at camp.
